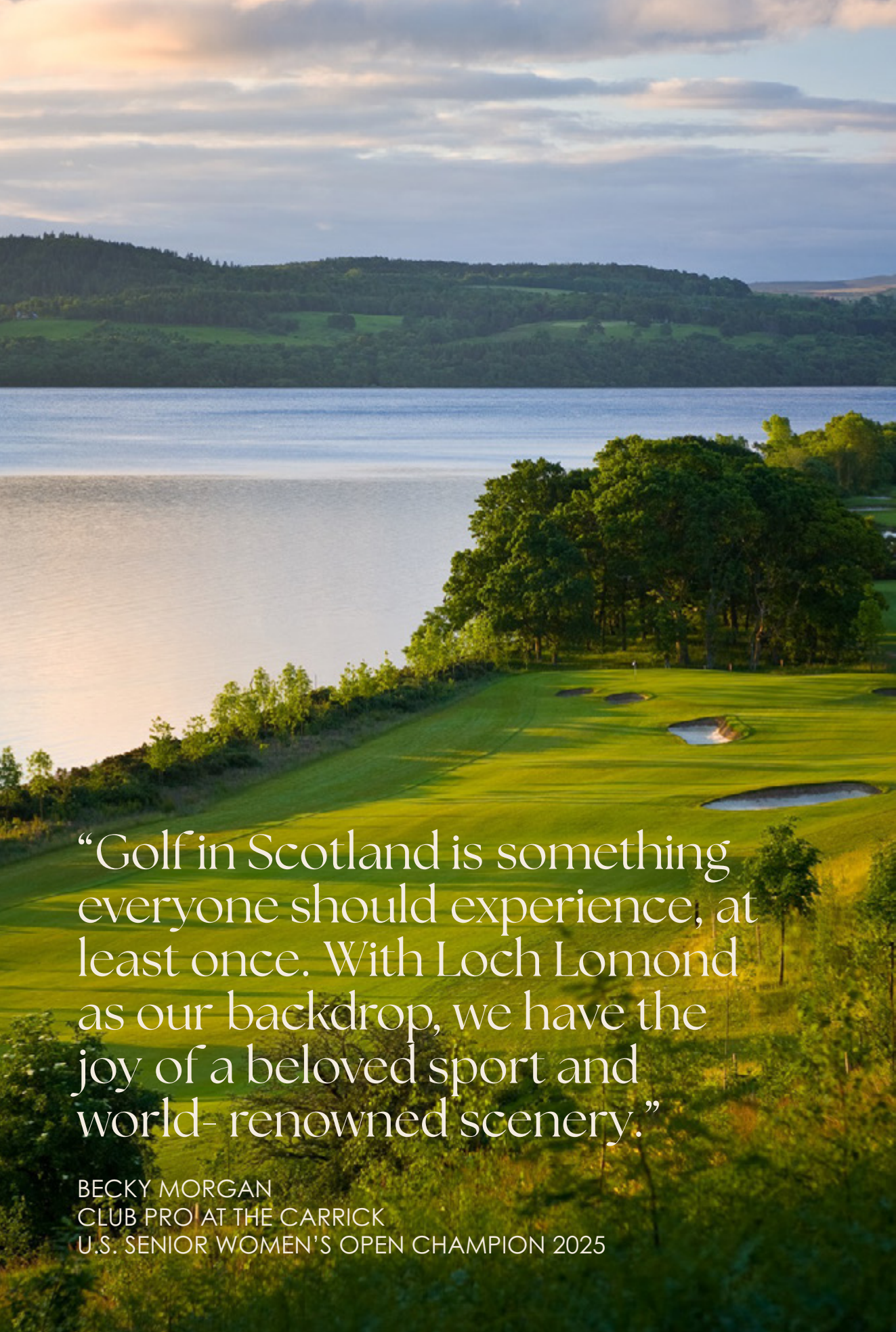

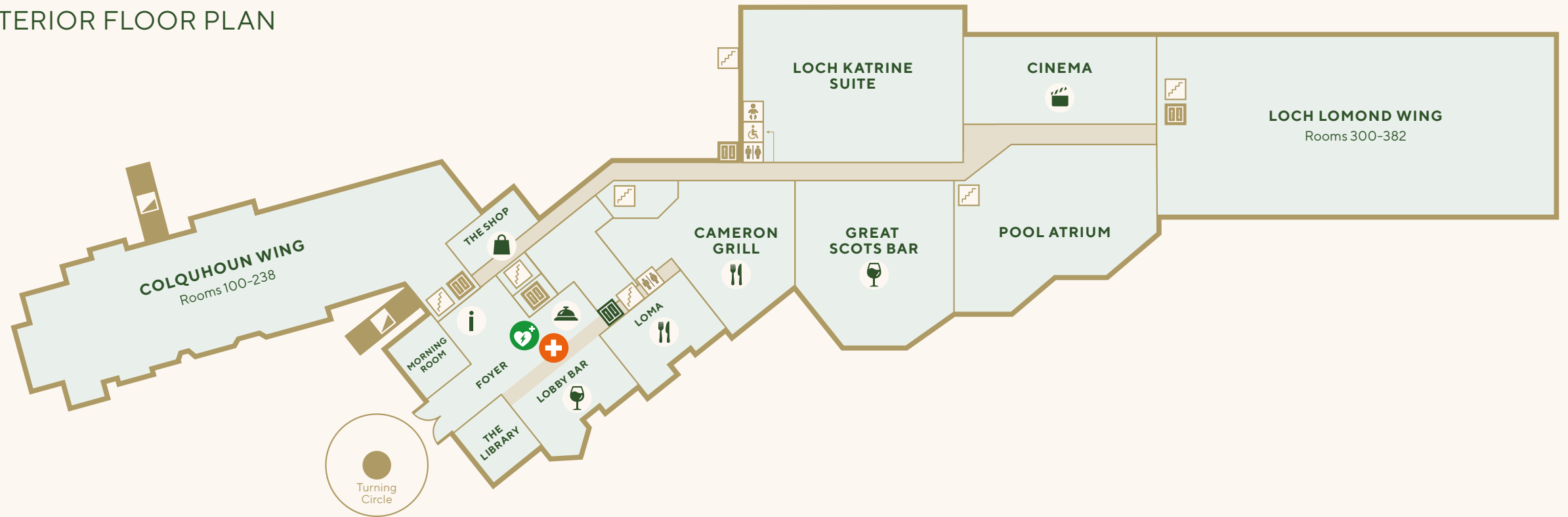

INTERIOR FLOOR PLAN

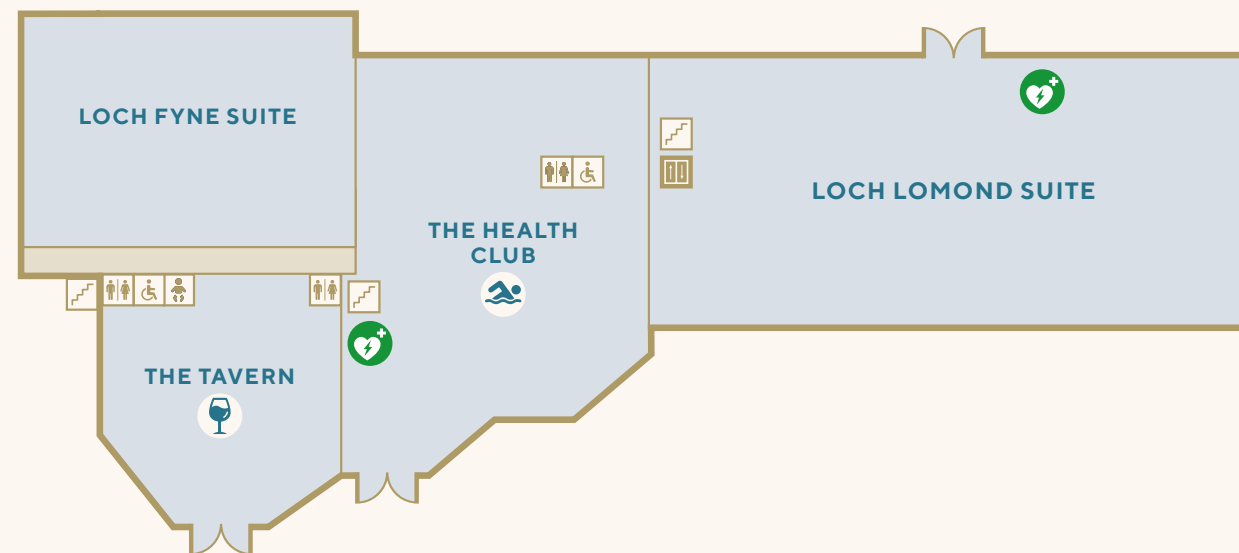
