Many of the wines are crafted by true artisans, whose intention is to make balanced, food-worthy wines, all of them representing great value relative to their price.

When it comes to pairing wine with food there are some classic combinations that will make your dining experience one to remember. Personal tastes play a big part when combining flavours in wine that will accompany food. As Sommeliers, our aim is to suggest wines based on the characteristics of the food, and to balance this with flavours and textures found in wine.

White wines that are un-oaked, fresh and vibrant with good acidity can compliment dishes like smoked salmon; aromatic whites, such as our Gruner Veltliner, will compliment the Scottish Scollops

White wines that have been fermented and aged in oak will generally be fuller bodied and have more structure, making them easier to pair with meatier fish such as Monkfish, but will equally compliment the chicken dish.

Red wines that are light to medium in body with soft tannins will usually compliment poultry and game; try a Gevrey Chambertin with the venison or the lighter Blaufrankisch with our Dover sole.

Red wines that have been fermented and aged in oak usually have more structure and complexity with more pronounced tannins; red Bordeaux like the Chateau Talbot 2017 from Saint Julien with the aged rib eye on the bone is a fantastic combination, or try our Stratus Cabernet Franc 2017 from Canda with ribeye and pepper sauce.

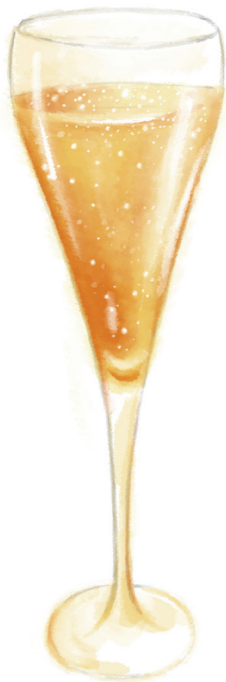

Rich black fruits pervade in a very fine aromatic profile, while on the palate the fruit is brilliantly clear and pure, with an intense attack and lengthy persistence. There is a great balance of flavours, hints of minerality and silky smooth tannins, very impressive.</p>	£30.00

Champagne is a well-loved variety of sparkling white wine produced according to specific rules in the Champagne region of France. Synonymous with celebration, champagne is typically produced from a few specific varieties of grapes: pinot noir, chardonnay, and pinot meunier.

Champagne, like all wines, is an experience for all of the senses – colour, aroma, texture, flavour and in this case sound too. Learning to recognise and define the distinctions in Champagne – making associations, finding the right word – is what makes tasting Champagne especially fascinating.

Our brain has to distinguish between nuances of white, yellow and pink; between fruity, spicy and floral aromas; between subtle, delicate and powerful aromas – between all those different qualities that make Champagne wine so irresistible, up to and including its magical bubbles.

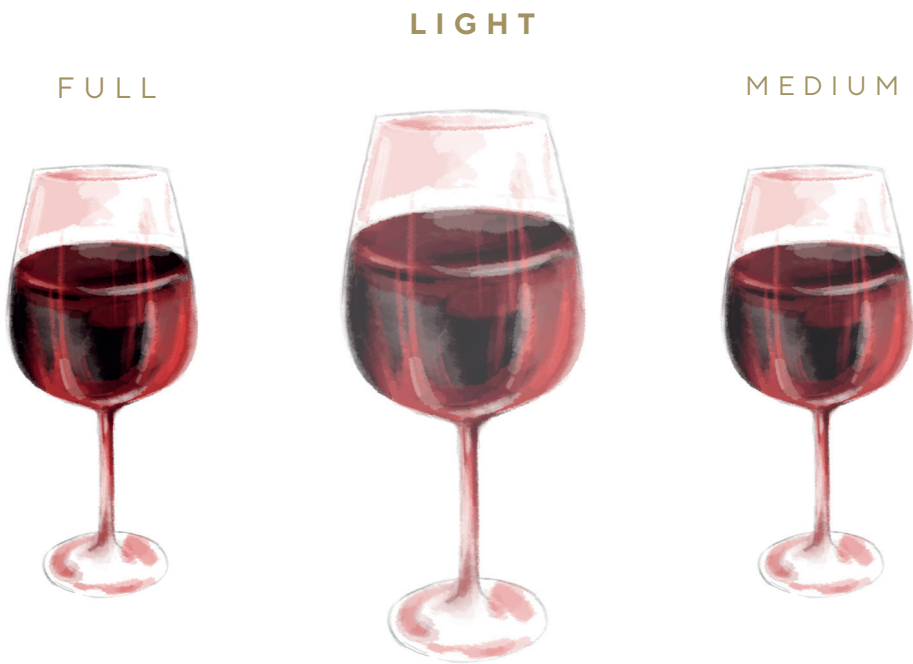

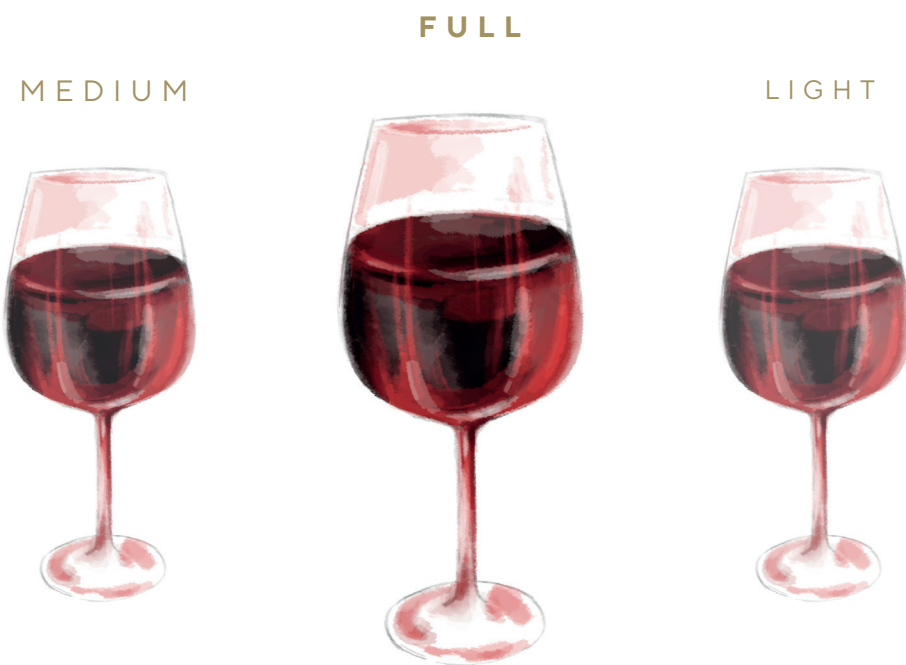

SWEET WINES AND PORT



There is a technical definition to “sweet wine”: If a wine has more than 30 grams per liter of residual sugar in it, it’s considered “sweet.” If there are less than 10 grams per liter, it’s considered “dry,” or the opposite of sweet in the world of wine. Anything in between is considered “off-dry.” Wines with full, pleasant flavours that are sweet and ‘rounded’ in nature are described as rich. In dry wines, richness may come from high alcohol, by complex flavours or by an oaky vanilla character. Decidedly sweet wines are also described as rich when the sweetness is backed up by fruity, ripe flavours.
